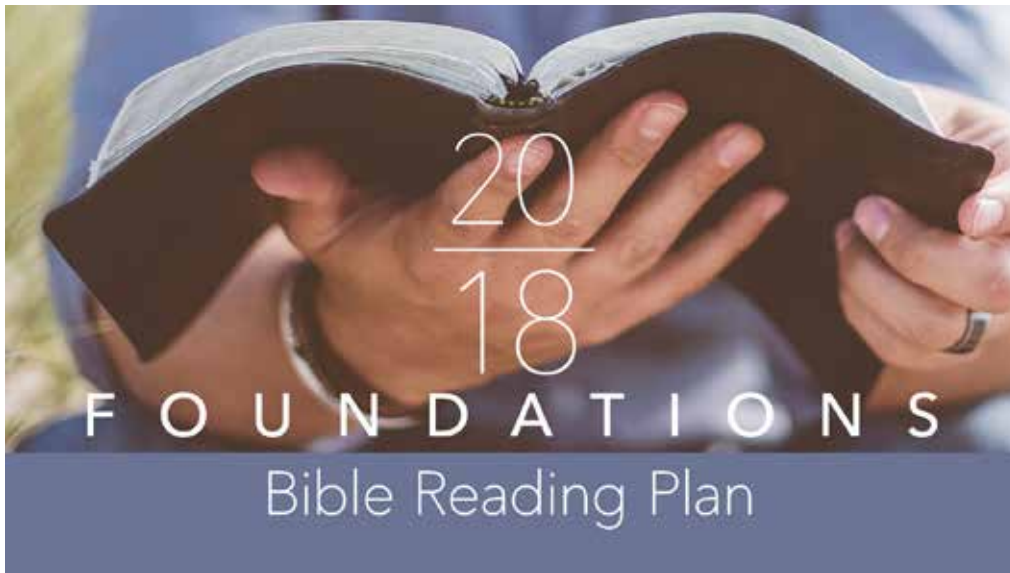
Hunter Street College Passion Conference
