Mission: Mom Possible

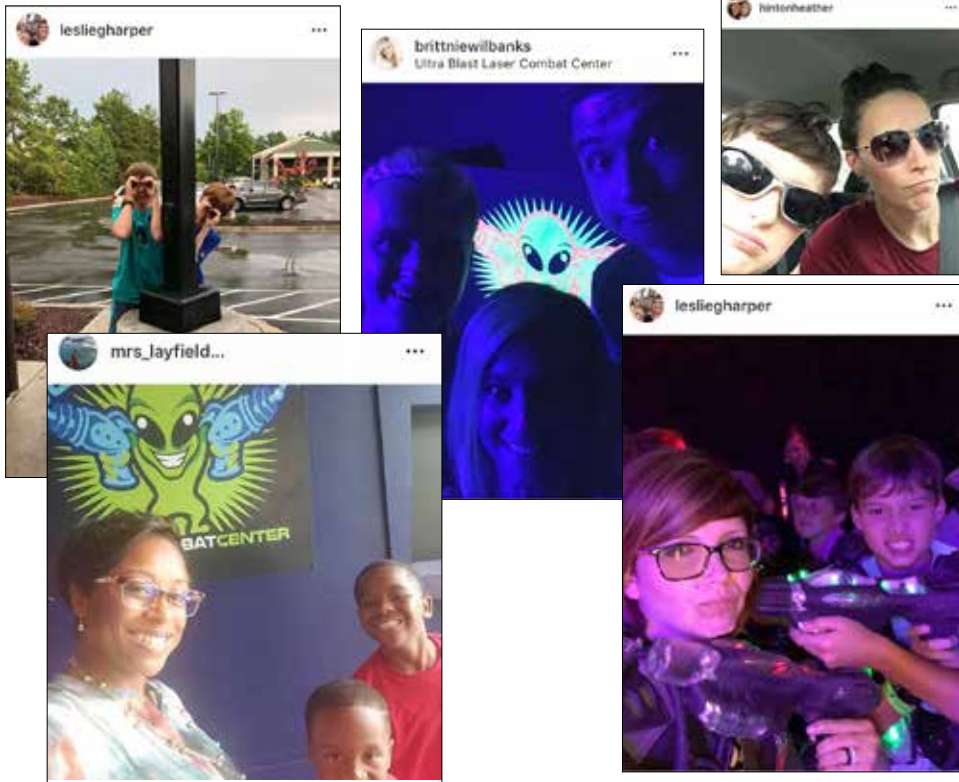
