is a new Small Group just getting started. If this group describes you, come and visit this Sunday. The Newly Engaged/Just Married group meets at 11:00am in Room S118.



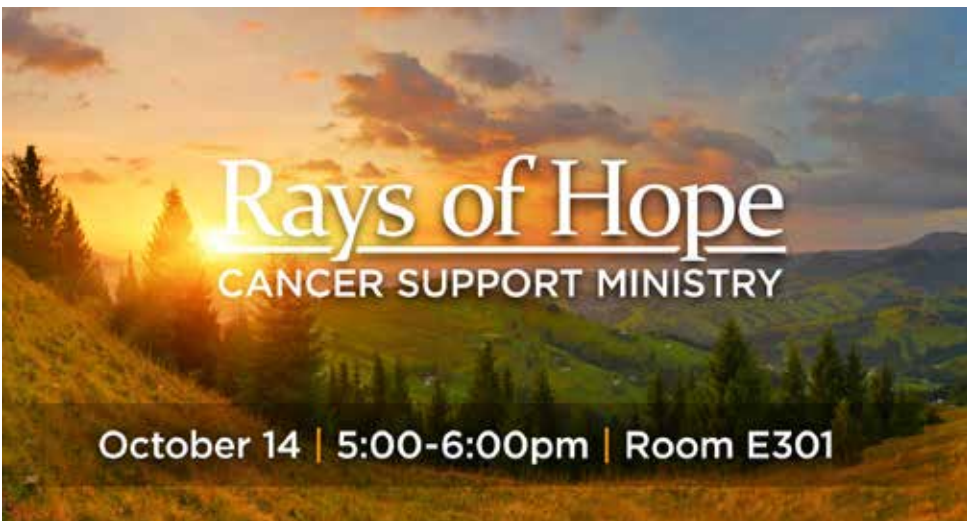
