In All Things Give Thanks

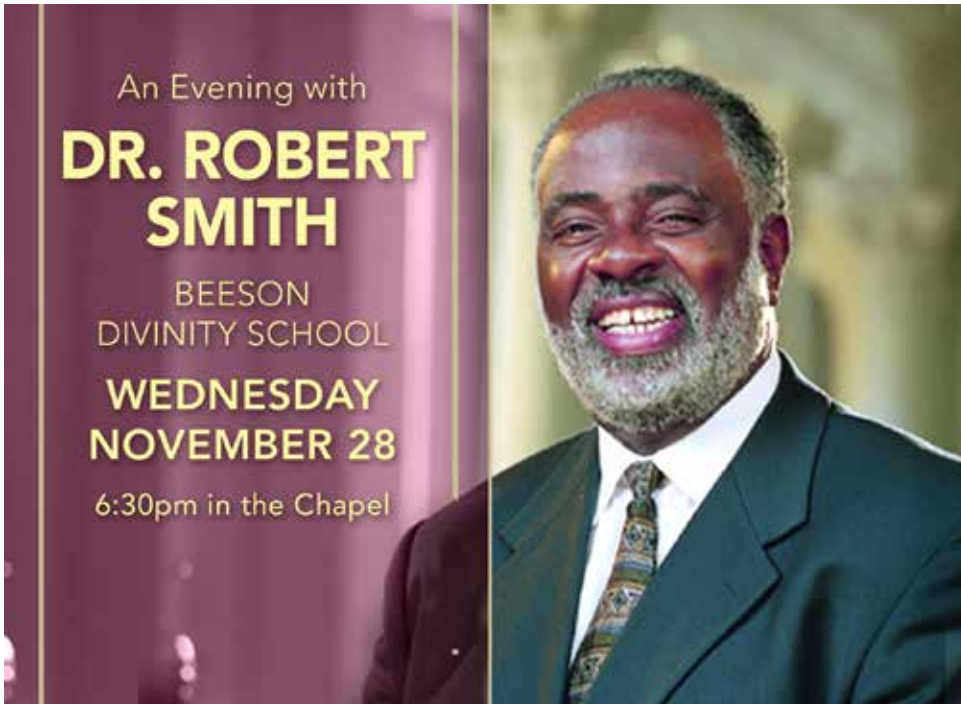
