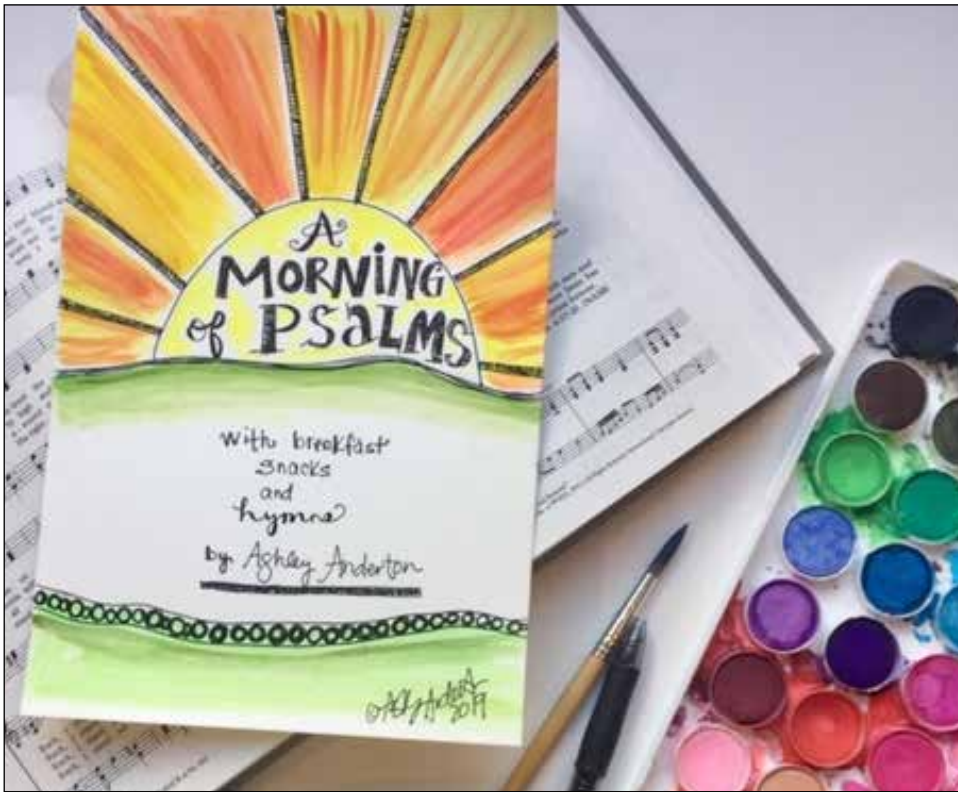
The Spring Term of WNL will begin **March 13**. This three week mini-term will offer several great classes. More to come on Hunterstreet.org.
